

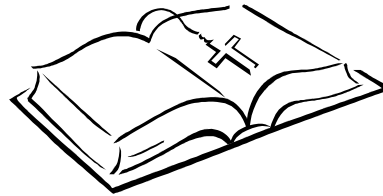
K5 Memory Work
